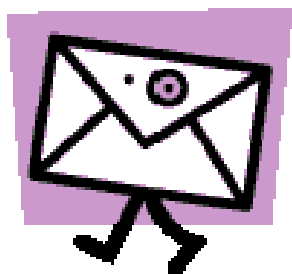


# Awareness Program
