## *Nothing to Fear: Franklin and Eleanor Roosevelt's America*

Roosevelt's New Deal initiated a series of federal programs designed to relieve the hardships of unemployment and to restore national prosperity and public confidence. Mrs. Roosevelt, nicknamed "Eleanor Everywhere" by the press, traveled where her husband could not go and reported back to him on the success of the New Deal programs.

New Dealers sought to build a nation in which as the Roosevelt's promised, "no one left out." Professor Gary Hylander will be presenting this intriguing story. Professor Hylander earned his Ph. D. at Boston College. Currently he is an independent scholar who specializes as a Presidential Historian. He is a visiting professor at Framingham State University, on the staff at Boston University School of Education, and a pedagogical specialist for the National Endowment for the Humanities.
